A NOTE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear LSU Families.

The continued distribution of COVID-19 vaccines has provided a welcomed light at the end of the



pandemic tunnel that we've been in for the past year. With each passing day, we are closer to the highly anticipated day when we will resume living and learning on our campus as we did prior to the pandemic. And while we are not there yet, we expect we will be by the fall semester.

We are very excited to be preparing for the vast majority of our classes to be face-to-face in the fall semester, as they were before COVID upended our lives, assuming vaccine distribution continues to proceed as expected. In the meantime, we will continue to closely monitor the state's COVID-19 progress and vaccine distribution, and we will follow all state and CDC guidelines, with the safety of our campus community as our guidepost. We have not yet finalized our plan for how classes will be held during the summer session and intersession, but we are hoping to have an update on that soon. We are also working on our plan for spring commencement and we will also keep you updated about that as well.

As we move forward with our spring semester, we also continue to work on expanding and enhancing our mental health services, academic support, and various other support services for students. Since November, we have been able to serve nearly 25% more students with academic advising appointments each week, and we are now adding 25 personnel to further accommodate more students this semester.

The <u>Student Health Center</u> has hosted hundreds of programs and outreach events to assist students since last fall, and it has also implemented several new initiatives, including mental health consultation programs, suicide prevention training, and screening tools for mental health and substance use issues. Our new <u>Student Success Help Desk</u> at the Student Welcome Center has been positively received since it was launched earlier this semester, and we are encouraging all students who are seeking additional support to visit the help desk or reach out to them by phone (225-578-2634) or by email (success@lsu.edu).

As we look forward with great hope that we are nearing a return to normalcy at LSU, I am very grateful for your continued support, patience, and flexibility. Stay safe and Geaux Tigers!
