Which New Internet Speed Do I Need?


The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) defines high speed internet as 25 Mbps for download and 3 Mbps for upload speed. This is a good speed, but for all of today's internet-device filled world – most households are needing more speed. So what speed are in needing?

The first question to ask yourself is HOW do you use the internet?

- · Are you just a Facebook and email checker or are you streaming and gaming?
- How many people use your internet connection?

For example, if you have children who each are using a laptop, smart phone, and a gaming console. If all these devices are running at the same time, you need to make sure you will have enough bandwidth to cover all of the connections simultaneously. In this situation, 25 Mbps would not be enough, and we would recommend 75-100 Mbps to avoid any buffering and long download times.

Make A Call Before You Dig A Hole


If you plan to begin any project that involves digging — such as building a patio, putting up a fence, or planting bushes and trees — remember to call 811 before work begins.

Every digging job requires a call to 811 to have underground utility lines marked. In some cases, lines are buried close to the surface and could easily be damaged by even shallow

digging, resulting in service interruptions to your neighborhood.

When you call, simply tell the operator where you're planning to dig and what type of work you'll be doing. The affected local utilities will send a locator to your property, free of charge. Then you'll know what's below and be able to dig safely.
