Concur Reports Now Available in BAH

Four reports displaying Concur data are now available from the 'Concur' tab within the Budget & Finance space of [BAH!](#) The four reports are:

- Concur Expense Reports: Use this report to view all expenses assigned to a Concur Expense Report.
- Outstanding Card Charges: Use this report to view unreconciled credit card transactions.
- Credit Card Transactions: Use this report to view information on all Concur-related card products (including the Procurement Card, Travel & Expense Card, and CTS air & hotel cards).
- Credit Cardholders: Use this report to view all cardholders that have used their university-issued credit card.

Capital Project - FF&E (Furniture, Fixtures, and Equipment) Approval Workflow Change

Starting May 1, future projects created for FF&E capital project purchases should be created with the department's Project Owning Organization with the associated Financial Unit. Currently, all capital project FF&E purchases are approved by a centralized department with FinU 9699908. For all newly created FF&E projects, those purchases should be approved by your department financial unit approver.

What transactions will be affected?

- Requisitions.
- Change Orders.

- Invoices.
- Cost Transfers.
- Concur Requests.

What is not changing? All existing capital projects will continue to be under FinU 9699908 and approved by the centralized department, journals, and Medical Center capital projects.

When requesting for capital project FF&E set-up, the Financial Unit Name and Code will need to be included.

Tips & Tricks

Resolving Alerts in Concur On Your Own!

Did you know that we have two Knowledge Base Articles (KBAs) that provide guidance on how to resolve alerts in Concur? The first KBA is the [How to Resolve Alerts in Concur](#) and it will assist you with troubleshooting common system messages in Concur when submitting Request and/or Expense Reports. It includes a table with Alert Text and the Steps to Take to resolve the issue in order to successfully submit your Request or Expense Report.

The second KBA is the [How to Resolve COA/POETAF Failed Validation Errors in Concur](#). This article also has a table that breaks down the various CoA and POETAF errors, what they mean and how you can resolve it. Both of these KBAs are a great resource to review before submitting a case about an alert that you do not know how to resolve in Concur. This will save you time and empower you to become a Concur super-user!

When does the Use of Per Diem Apply to your Trip?

For travel Inside of the Continental United States, Per Diem applies for 30 days or more of travel. You can also claim Per Diem for travel Outside of the Continental United States (including Alaska, Hawaii, and US territories like Puerto Rico or Guam) and all foreign destinations.

There are two ways you can claim per diem on your trip:

- [Travel Allowance Feature](#): Concur has a built-in feature to help you claim Per Diem called the Travel Allowance Feature. When this feature is used and the dates and locations of travel have been inputted, the system will automatically calculate the appropriate Per Diem rates for the location traveled.
- Attaching the Published Per Diem Rates: We understand that there are more complex travel scenarios, so if you do not use the Travel Allowance feature, you will be required to attach a copy of the Published Per Diem rates sheet. This can

be obtained from the [State Department website](#) as your supporting documentation. At time of audit at the Central Office we will reference this document when reviewing your meals and lodging expenses. The Central Office does not have visibility to the published rates when the travel allowance feature is not used.

When claiming Per Diem, please note that per UCOP Travel Policy G-28, the expense report should reflect the traveler's actual costs up to the allowable amount. Claiming actual expenses is the best use of the University's funds.
