Right before Thanksgiving, Jenna and I returned from an epic adventure visiting all our clients in **Kenya**. I have to say, we have a terrific portfolio (at all price ranges) and our clients are awesome to work with. And having nine nights in the **Mara** was pretty spectacular!

We visited all five of the **Atua Enkop** properties starting with **Elephant Gorge** in **Amboseli**, a spectacular property that will be just 20 minutes from the park gate come March (*they're building a new road!*).

Moving north from **Nairobi**, **Elephant Bedroom Camp** was lovely and the wildlife viewing outstanding. Yes, we had rain — and the camp was evacuated for two weeks just as we were leaving — but it has since reopened. By the way, the Northern Big Five were out and about in Samburu.

Mbweha Camp in the **Great Rift Valley** was a nice surprise. We had an outstanding night game drive, and my new favorite nocturnal animal is a Spring Hare. Ducking into the national park, we saw lions and rhino and tons of other game. Sundowners at **Lake Elementaita** were extra special.

At **Mara Ngenche Camp** we enjoyed the plunge pool, the hammocks and being pampered by the staff. We finished our tour of the **Atua Enkop** properties at **Tipilikwani Mara Camp**, a larger property with huge tents on the **Talek River**. Great value and their bathtubs are outstanding!

We stayed three nights at the new **Mara Siana Camp** in the **Ripoi Conservancy**. Owned by three legendary Masai guides (including Jackson Looseyia) and three American women investors, the camp is really special. So far they only have four tents open, so Mara Siana is very intimate. The guiding, the food and the conservancy were

exceptional and tracking a lion with two of Kenya's top guides was incredible.

Then it was on to what I now consider **EcoTraining**'s best camp — the **Mara Training Centre at House in the Wild**. During our stay, five students were doing a guide training course. Yes, shared bathrooms and showers, but they are just a few steps from the dorms. This is a terrific option for people who want in-depth guide training or African nature study, especially those on a tight budget.

After saying goodbye to Jenna, I pampered myself with a two-night Spafari at the **JW Marriott Masai Mara Lodge**. Since I'd already been in the Mara for seven nights, I decided to just relax, enjoy the world-class spa, and hang out in the Canon Photo Studio. The staff was exceptional, the vegan food delicious and there was a steady stream of guests using the complimentary Canon cameras and then editing their photos with the two resident photographers.


