We are already getting requests from students who will be gone on the dates of final exams. Because of our shift towards standards based grading, we have also gotten away from policy about "early" final exams. Instead we have this currently in our student handbook. Please use it as guidance for when students indicate they will be gone on the date of the planned final.

The purpose of finals is to show students that learning is a semester long process and finals demonstrate proficiency on the standards in a content area. Final exams will be administered during the last week of each semester. It is expected that a final assessment occurs in ALL classes during the final week of each semester. The final exam can take the form of a subjective/objective assessment or include a performance-based criteria. Students have the responsibility to complete all work.

**MISSED FINAL EXAMS-** If final exams are not completed on their scheduled date at the end of a semester, the opportunity to take the final exams may come early or late. The lowest possible score will be entered for the final until taken.
