Learning Blade Pilot

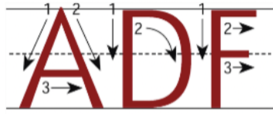

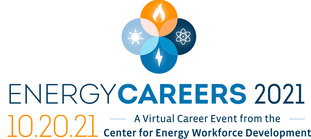
