#### Jerry Hernandez Secures 500 Wins as Lasers' Head Coach

On January 19, Jerry Hernandez led the Men's Basketball team to victory over Golden West College, securing his 500th win as the Lasers' head coach. Hernandez recently completed his 24th season as the men's head basketball coach at IVC. Under his guidance, the team achieved significant milestones, including a school record of 27 wins in the 2008-09 season and reaching the state tournament for the first time in 2009-10. Hernandez's coaching tenure has been marked by consistent playoff appearances, 20 or more wins in 10 seasons, and a No. 1 state ranking in 2013. His players have earned numerous accolades, with over 100 receiving scholarships at four-year colleges, including Division I institutions.
