Visiting Students Programs —

- Up to 8 Scholarships to develop research in ICT
- 2 to 6 months at CMU
- For Students enrolled in a Master's Program at a Portuguese Higher Institution

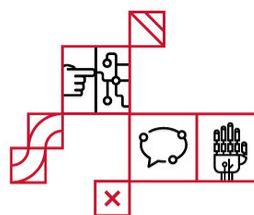

We bring together two leaders in the field of HCI which represent a new generation of interdisciplinary research and education. A designer (Jodi Forlizi) and a Psychologist (Yvonne Rogers), two brilliant women that lead the top HCI departments in the world of Computer Science.
