ParkZen App: Driving through the parking lots at LSU to search for an open parking space can be stressful. To address this, Manos Chatzopoulos, assistant professor of Physics & Astronomy, has developed a [free smartphone app](#) to assist drivers in locating available parking on LSU's campus.

Partnering with LSU Parking and Transportation Services, ParkZen is now available through the LSU Mobile App. ParkZen utilizes smart data analytics to identify real-time open parking spaces and then broadcasts parking availability in the general proximity of selected campus parking lots. ParkZen can also locate a parked vehicle so there is no need to wander around the lot searching for a car.

Student Health Center: The Student Health Center's Mental Health Service is offering an Emotional Wisdom series which covers a variety of topics related to coping skills to help students manage their emotional and mental health. All sessions will be held in-person at MHS (second floor of the Student Health Center) on Wednesdays at 3 p.m.
