LSU Dining and Spring Meal Plans:

First and Second Year Students Living on Campus

- Sign up/change your meal plan through myLSU after registering for classes.
- The deadline to sign up/change your meal plan of choice is the 14th day of class, Tuesday, January 29th, 2019. If you have not signed up by then, you'll be automatically assigned to the 12 Tiger Meals.
- Remaining Paw Points from the Fall will roll over to the spring if you purchased a spring meal plan that includes Paw Points. Transfer will occur after the 14th day of class.

Commuter Students

- Commuter meal plans are NOT automatically assessed to your account, so sign up through myLSU.
- Deadline to purchase a meal plan is Tuesday, January 29, 2019.
- Remaining Paw Points from the fall will roll over to the spring if you purchased a spring meal plan that includes Paw Points. Transfer will occur after the 14th day of class.
