In order to comply with the COVID-19 Fall 2021 entry protocols, all LSU students will need to provide one of the following items **prior to arriving on campus** for the Fall 2021 semester:

- Proof of a negative COVID-19 test result no more than 5 days prior to your arrival on campus
- Proof of COVID-19 vaccination
- Proof of a positive COVID-19 test result no more than 90 days prior to your arrival on campus

Any student who tests positive for COVID-19 during this process should report their positive test in <u>LSU's Daily Symptom Checker</u> and should isolate at home according to LSU's <u>COVID-19 protocols</u>. Click <u>here</u> for more info on the COVID Entry Test Procedure.

All students living on campus should have received their LSU Box number assignment via their LSU email. All USPS mail and non-perishable courier delivered packages (Amazon, UPS, FedEx, etc.) should be shipped to this box using this address format:

When the student receives mail or packages, they will be alerted via email to come to the UPS Store in the Union to pick it up. Please be aware that USPS tracking shows delivery to Baton Rouge, not to the UPS Store. It can take an extra 1-2 days to reach our campus store. There is no USPS delivery to campus on Saturday.

Parking & Transportation Services: This year, we are pleased to offer a new \$50 permit

option, Park-N-Geaux, that will allow for parking in a remote location on Skip Bertman Dr. The Park-N-Geaux program will serve as an express shuttle across campus from the Tiger Park Lot to Engineering Ln. with a bus leaving each location every 10-15 minutes. This service will be in operation Monday through Friday from 6:00 am – 6:00 pm.

**Student Health Center:** The LSU Student Health Center is now in-network with most major health insurance plans! Students now have the convenience of using their health insurance on campus. \*Students can now upload their health insurance card to support a seamless billing process, <u>Isu.edu/shcportal</u>.

The Student Health Fee will continue to supplement medical care and to cover wellness and mental health programs, services, and events, including:

- Telephone triage;
