Import questions from Word documents or create questions directly in Respondus 4.0®, preview your exams, then publish directly to your Canvas course. You can also Import tests from The Respondus Test Bank Network® which contains thousands of test banks for the leading textbooks in higher education. Instructors who use Respondus 4.0 can easily create online exams from these official publisher test banks.
