- 1. Calling the interviewer by the wrong name.

- 5. Not making eye contact.
- 6. Spreading negativity.
- 7. Not taking the interview seriously.
- 8. Not doing their research.
- 9. Showing poor judgment.
- 10. Getting stuck in their phone.
- 11. Saying they just wanted their money.
- 12. Making sexist comments.
