September is absolutely beautiful in Buena Vista and we have a full slate of events, races and activities happening all month long. (Check out the Events Calendar below!)

I thought I'd share a Welcome Center update! So we opened our doors on June 24, 2024. We were open 5 days a week from 10:00am to 3:00pm. We started off Monday through Friday and switched to Tuesday - Saturday partway through the summer. We were staffed solely by volunteers!

We had face-to-face conversations with nearly 1,000 people in just about 2 and a half months. I think that's pretty spectacular especially considering we missed most of June and had limited hours! We talked with visitors about where to eat, who to boat with, where to stay, where to hike, where to shop, RV dump spots, and whatever other crazy and delightful questions they had for us. We talked with locals about shuttle services, building contractors, automotive needs, schools, jobs, real estate agents, events, nonprofits and more. We promoted responsible recreation, fire safety and leave no trace. We know we took some burden off of businesses and Town Hall by having our doors open and being the friendly, welcoming faces of BV.

We passed out countless flyers and brochures and talked up our local businesses and nonprofit members to everyone who stopped in.

We are working to expand our capacity, extend our hours next season, and serve more people. We are creating plans to collaborate with other local organizations to continue to our responsible recreation messaging as well. We continue to welcome our members to post flyers in the window and drop off brochures for our shelves.

We'll probably shorten our hours later in the fall to give our volunteers a well-earned break but we are happy with how this went and do plan to continue operations!

It takes a time, resources, and funding to conduct this work and I'm very excited to announce the soft launch our <u>Sponsorhip program</u>. If you love what we are up to and want to help us do it bigger, better and more elegantly, we'd love your support to build that capacity.


