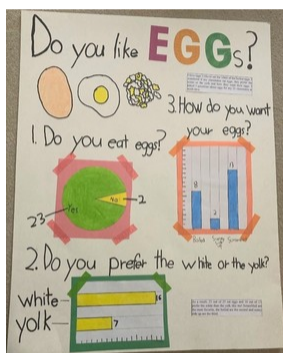
## Please Provide Your Input for Fall Science Update
