Internal Medicine Resident

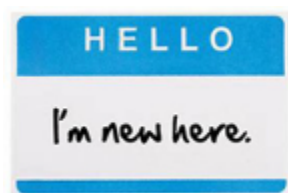

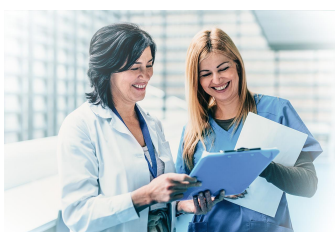

Austin Area Family Medicine Physicians Needed to Serve as Volunteer Preceptors

Dell Medical School at The University of Texas at Austin is looking for family medicine physicians in the Austin area to serve as volunteer preceptors for the Primary Care, Family, and Community Medicine Clerkship. The PCFCM Clerkship is a two-year, longitudinal experience in which our students are paired 1:1 with an outpatient primary care preceptor. The students attend clinic with their preceptor roughly one half-day per week from September-June of their MS2 and MS3 years.

Our preceptors will be given an affiliate faculty appointment with Dell Medical School, which gives them free access to the UT Library system and any Dell Medical School continuing medical education offerings.
