Update to the FindMe-IVC Print Queue Default Settings

As of May 1, the default printer setting in the FindMe-IVC print queue will be set to grayscale instead of auto color. Previously, all jobs sent to the printer/copier were set to color unless the user manually selected grayscale. With the higher cost per page for printing in color, users found themselves paying a higher print fee than desired. This update will help reduce overall costs by only printing documents in color that are meant to be in that format.
