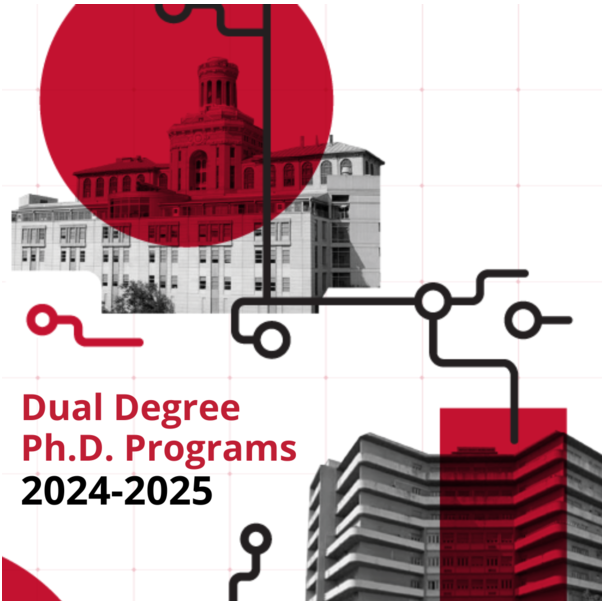

### CMU Portugal Welcomes 18 New Ph.D. Candidates

The CMU Portugal Program welcomes 18 new Ph.D. students for the 2024/25 academic year, including 7 Dual Degree and 11 Affiliated Ph.D. students.

The new Dual Degree students will participate in a full-time program, spending 2 years at CMU and 3 years at a Portuguese university. Candidates are affiliated with four Portuguese higher education institutions and four CMU departments and will conduct their research in Computer Science, Languages Technologies, Engineering and Public Policy, and Software Engineering.

The new Affiliated Ph.D. students will be hosted at six Portuguese universities and six CMU departments. Their research projects will be conducted in close collaboration with industry partners, such as AMBISIG, Invisible Lab, PDMFC, Unbabel, and VMWare.

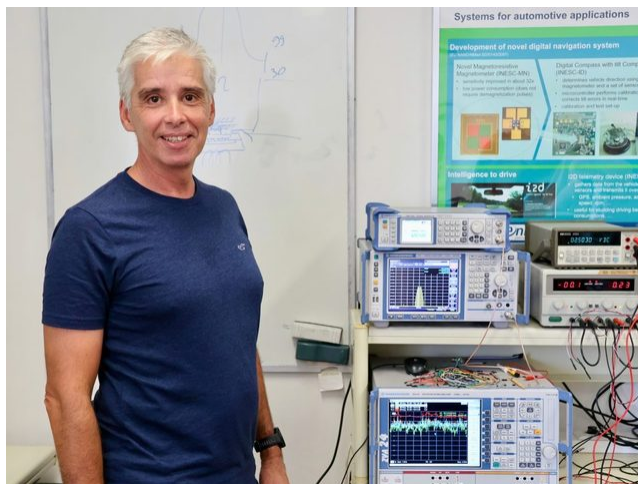


### CMU Portugal researchers at UC awarded for their Innovative Research

The winning project “E-skins: Wearable Bio Stickers for Long-Term Electrophysiology”, focuses on the development of electronic patches for monitoring health data, such as heartbeat and brain activity, The project builds on the findings of the CMU Portugal Large Scale Collaborative Research project WoW.

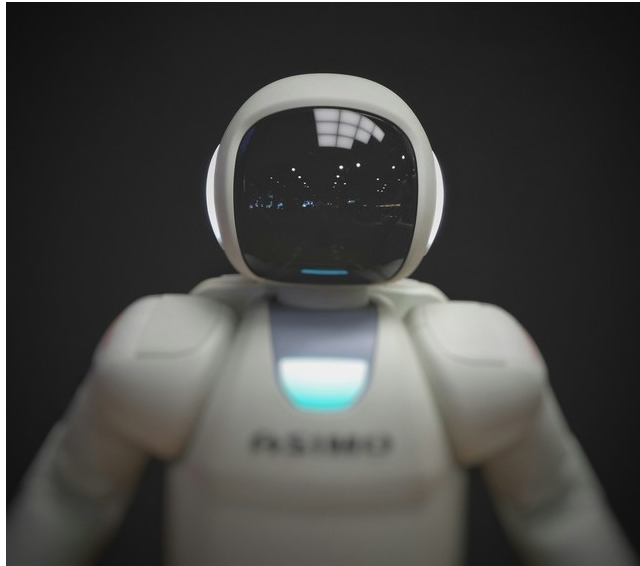


### CMU Portugal Faculty Featured in Newly Launched CMU SCS Podcast
