- Athens has moved up a spot on Allianz Partners' Top 10 Summer European Destinations list that shows where Americans intend to travel to this year. The Greek capital city climbed up one spot to 7th place on the list.
- A survey by the British Post Office revealed Athens as one of the cheapest cities in Europe for a city-break vacation. In a survey of 35 European cities, Athens ranked as the fourth cheapest (262 GBP for a weekend holiday) vs its neighboring Venice (687 GBP for a weekend) or Barcelona & Roma (500+ GBP).


Greece is a destination that can satisfy a wide range of travelers due to its diverse offerings throughout the year. We have gathered together our favorite ones that you can choose with a little
