was promoted to general manager of the Nexstar Media Group, overseeing broadcast and digital operations in Huntsville, Ala.



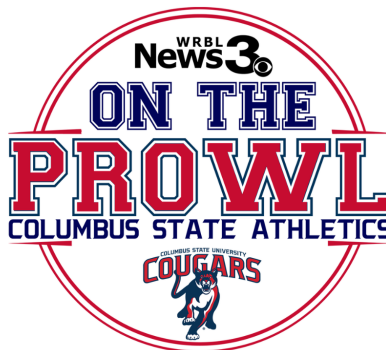
