Project Type Name Update

As communicated in the 9/28/23 Digest, new project types were created and an existing one had a name change, in support of the Fixed Assets Project.

This name change has caused some confusion for campus users so the name is being changed again, effective November 18, to alleviate this confusion.

Project Type New Name: UCSD Sponsor Project Pre FA (originally UCSD Sponsor Project, then DNU UCSD Sponsor Project).

Foundation Recurring Transfers

You are encouraged to set up a recurring transfer for your Foundation funds (fund number begins A-L). The available full balance will be transferred to your specified chart string monthly, reducing your administrative burden to submit individual requests. Any unspent balance will carryforward year to year, so there is no need to wait to transfer funds. This will also make seeing your full balances on existing BAH reports easier.

To make this request, complete a Foundation [request for funds form](#) leaving the amount field blank and checking the recurring box. Submit your completed form to [UC San Diego Services & Support Portal](#), About: Gift Funds; Related to: Gift Fund Setup & Transfer; More Specifically: Foundation Requests for Funds Transfer.

Payment Process for Non-Employee Students

This is a friendly reminder that **non-employee students** need to register through PaymentWorks to receive their reimbursement. They must be [invited to register](#) in PaymentWorks by a UC San Diego employee, and should not log in with their student SSO.

If the student is an employee at UC San Diego, you must reimburse them either by acting as a delegate on their Concur profile (for Travel Expenses), or via the Non-PO Payment to Employee form (for other expenses and reimbursements).

If you need to confirm the employment status of a student, please use the [Supplier Inquiry Report](#) in the Business Activity Hub to search for their employee supplier profile.
