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## New BA/BFA Program

### Takes Flight

A new pairing of Oberlin degree programs enables students to establish their own paths toward interdisciplinary careers across the arts. Beginning in fall 2025, students may pursue a combined



dual degree that culminates in a Bachelor of Arts and a Bachelor of Fine Arts in Integrated Arts. The two degrees can be completed in five years: the first four on Oberlin's campus, followed by a fifth year in Cleveland. Current sophomores are eligible to take part in the first BA/BFA class.
