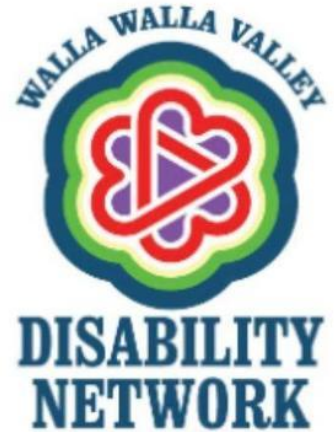

## A Note From Parent to Parent...

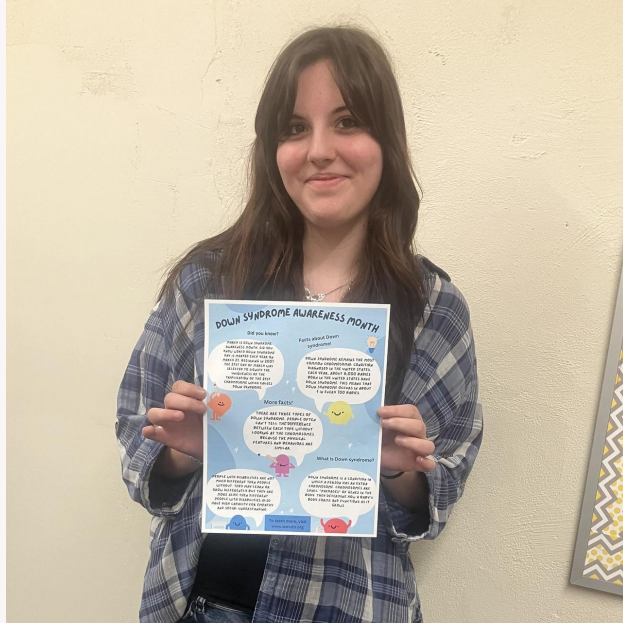
