### Summer 2026 Rural Non-Congregate Request Form and FAQs Now Available!

The request form for eligible SFSP and SSO operators wanting to serve non-congregate meals in rural areas for Summer 2026 is now available! Before submitting the form, all organizations must follow the guidance documented in the newly released 2026 Rural Summer Non-Congregate FAQs. ### RELEASE: School Data for Area Eligibility Report

On an annual basis, TDA must publish a list of schools participating in the National School Lunch Program (NSLP) in which at least one-half of the children are eligible for free or reduced-price meals. The School Data for Area Eligibility 2025-2026 report, based on October 2025 claims data for non-CEP schools and the April 2025 CEP ISP report for CEP schools, has been posted to SquareMeals in the following locations:

## SFSP Submission Reminders

- CE's wishing to receive an advance must submit in TXUNPS by March 15, 2026
- SFSP Training must be completed prior to submission of application in TXUNPS
- Be sure to include a copy of your training certificate and health department letter(s) when submitting your application. Private nonprofits and non federal government entities must complete the annual audit screen in TXUNPS
- Private nonprofits and government entities operating a site on public school property must obtain permission from the school district HQ. The permission letter must be provided to TDA along with submission of the site application
- Please review the maximum ADP site list on [SquareMeals](#) (located at the bottom of the page) before submitting your renewal application in TXUPS
- Stay tuned for FAQ updates to the SFSP/SSO non congregate site program

## New Rural Non-Congregate Proximity Flexibilities for Summer 2026

In Summer 2026, some school districts and sponsors in rural areas will be eligible to operate non-congregate sites within 2 miles of another summer site. Eligible organizations must demonstrate in their applications that they meet the criteria for using those flexibilities.
