Colombian Journeys

- 4 Colombian destinations for women travelers. Travel Off Path publication has listed 4 Colombian destinations recommended for women travelers that visit Colombia on their own. Read the full article here.
- 10 days in Bogota, must-see and ideal places...Among the must see places to visit in Bogota are La Candelaria, located in the city center and known for its culture, history, and museums. Quinta Camacho, a place with an incredible architecture influenced by an English style reflected on the streets, and several delicious restaurants like Salvaje, Abasto, Harry Sasson and many more. There are also numerous libraries in the capital city being the most famous the Virgilio Barco and the Julio Santo Domingo. And if you prefer to have an alternative option for getting to know the city, there are many bike paths to more around town in a calm and relaxed environment. To know more about this, click here.
- American Airlines will have more flights by the end of the year. The US carrier announced that, from December 20th, 2023 to April 7th, 2024, it will increase its air operations, expanding its seating capacity close to 50% compared to last year in flights to Barranquilla, Cartagena, and 90 weekly flights from Colombia to the United States.
- New route between Bogota and Orlando. Latam Airlines started operating daily routes between Bogotá and Orlando which is part of the commercial agreement with Delta Airlines. This will provide a more direct connectivity between Colombia and The United States, promoting a bilateral tourism for both Nations.
- According to a study published by Nature Portfolio, thanks to the development of sustainable tourism projects in the Colombian Eastern Plains, the extinction of Jaguars in the department of Casanare has diminished. After the analysis of various evaluation and observation criteria, it has been proven that for the year 2014 the probability of seeing a jaguar was of 0% and for 2020 was 40%. This species population grew considerably from 5 individuals in 2014 to 28 in 2020! Hato La Aurora is a private reserve that today is part of one of the conservation projects and it is the only place in Colombia where jaguar tourism is practiced in its natural surroundings. This place was formally established as a reserve in 2008 and the hunting has been prohibited in the farm since 1979. Projects like this suggest that the private lands with low intensity tourism and livestock can sustain the population of jaguars under the parameters of awareness and protection. 
The Great North also offers Lauca National Park, with its snowcapped Parinacota, deep blue Lake Chungara and starkly beautiful altiplano landscape.
