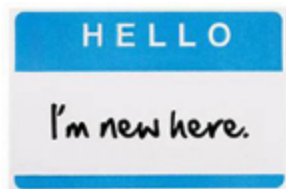
## TMB Clarifies New Fingerprinting Requirement Ahead of February License Renewals

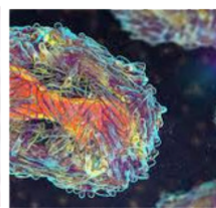
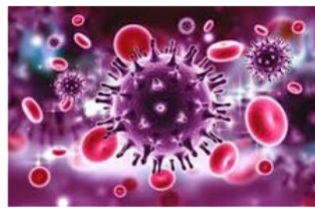
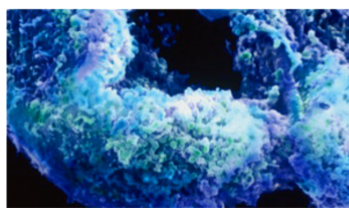
