Effective this month, all visitors arriving in Galapagos will have to fill out a declaration form with their personal details, luggage description and provide information about places with wild or domestic animals been visited within the last 72 hours. The new procedure is part of the Galapagos National Park's ongoing control measures to protect the islands' unique ecosystem. The form can be filled out online <u>here</u> up to 48 hours prior to the flight. A confirmation code will be sent to your email, which must be shown to Galapagos National Park representatives upon arrival.

Meet the Maremmas: Guardians of Patagonia


Everyone knows that dogs are man's best friend. But down in Patagonia, they're also great guardians, playing a crucial role in maintaining the balance of the ecosystem.

Pedaling Patagonia: Mountain Bike at River House Lodge



In the same way that Argentine Patagonia provides ideal conditions for hiking and horseback riding, it's also nirvana for mountain bikers.

River House Lodge can help design your own bespoke cycling routes and provide a guide to lead the way.

For a casual ride, explore the property's diverse trails on a mountain bike. For intermediate riders, Rosales Lagoon makes a great outing. While more experienced cyclists can venture deep into the National Park's rugged terrain. The lodge guides ensure a safe and enjoyable ride, with options for packed lunches and scenic stops.

The **Trailforks** app offers info and maps and 15 recommended bike rides and 200 overall routes around the town of San Martín de los Andes and Lanín National Park. The routes are rated from Easy (green circle) and More Difficult (blue square) to Very Difficult (black diamond) and at least one Extremely Difficult (double black diamond).

Guyana: The Ultimate Birder's Paradise



With upwards of 820 species — almost 200 of them found in capital city Georgetown — it should come as no surprise that **Guyana** is one of the world's top destinations to spot a mind-boggling variety of birds.

Of all nature's treasures in this tropical country, the birds are a special highlight for nature enthusiasts, with ample locations and trails suitable for birdwatchers.
