## Trail connecting downtown to Notre Dame set to begin construction

The City of South Bend announced this week that the new trail will begin in downtown South Bend in the plaza on the corner of LaSalle Avenue and Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard. It will take pedestrians and bicyclists east on LaSalle Avenue and will culminate at the Angela Boulevard and Notre Dame Avenue intersection where users can continue to the Notre Dame campus or join the multi-use path along Angela Boulevard.

# South Bend is vulnerable to lead poisoning — here's how ND-LIT can help

<u>Lead exposure</u> is suspected to be a significant issue for South Bend. The source is often lead-based paint, used widely in homes built before 1978. Eighty percent of the city's homes were built before then. Notre Dame's Lead Innovation Team, ND-LIT, spent Saturday in the historic Near Northwest Neighborhood scanning homes and soil for lead as part of its Mulch Madness event. ### Land donation supports new approach to affordable housing in South Bend

Notre Dame donated three plots of land to the Northeast Neighborhood Revitalization Organization, the nonprofit community development organization serving the increasingly popular Northeast Neighborhood south of campus. The land, along Turnock Street, will be used to build affordable, single-family homes as part of a <u>newly formed community land trust</u>, the first of its kind in Indiana.


