The North American Indian basketry collection includes 350 pieces representing groups from every major culture area and ranging in date from the early 19th century to the present. This image is one section of a Huron birch bark tray basket from Quebec, Canada. The birch bark is embellished with pictures of figures smoking pipes, embroidered in moose hair.
