• Iceland opens borders for vaccinated travelers from the US. The Icelandic government has announced new regulations, allowing travelers from the US, who have been vaccinated

- and can provide **official vaccination documents**, to enter the country without testing or quarantine.
- Iceland ProCruises has decided to postpone their 2021 sailing season start to July 2nd, 2021.
- Currently, the only US hub that Icelandair is departing from is **Boston**.
