- **Iceland opens borders for vaccinated travelers from the US.** The Icelandic government has announced new regulations, allowing travelers from the US, who have been vaccinated

and can provide **official vaccination documents**, to enter the country without testing or quarantine.

- Iceland ProCruises has decided to **postpone their 2021 sailing season start** to July 2nd, 2021.
 - Currently, the only US hub that Icelandair is departing from is **Boston**.

No harm is to be expected, as this is only a small eruption compared to the eruption of Eyjafjallajökull in 2010 and travellers do not have to expect any restrictions.
