Male Survivors of Domestic Violence

Domestic violence is often referred to as a "woman's issue." While it is true that women are more likely to experience abuse than men, it is essential to broaden the issue to include everyone who is affected if we truly believe that everyone deserves to feel safe and valued in their relationships.

Stats:

- 1 in 4 men have been physically abused by an intimate partner.
- 13.4% of male high school students report being physically or sexually abused by a dating partner.
- 4 in 10 men have experienced at least one form of coercive control by an intimate partner.

Empowering Survivors Support Group

Empowering Survivors is a support group for women who have experienced abuse or control in their marriage or relationship. This group focuses on positive support and encouragement.

The group meets virtually every Monday from 6-7:30pm and is facilitated by a Safe Harbor counselor.

Participants will not be asked to share details of their abuse, but rather, explore the impact it has had on their lives and work towards healing and hope in a supportive environment.

We offer a neutral space for survivors to connect with other survivors to gain hope and strength and to understand that abuse is not your fault.

You do not have to be a Safe Harbor client to attend.
