Kobo and **iTunes** will have the ebook available no later than October 6.

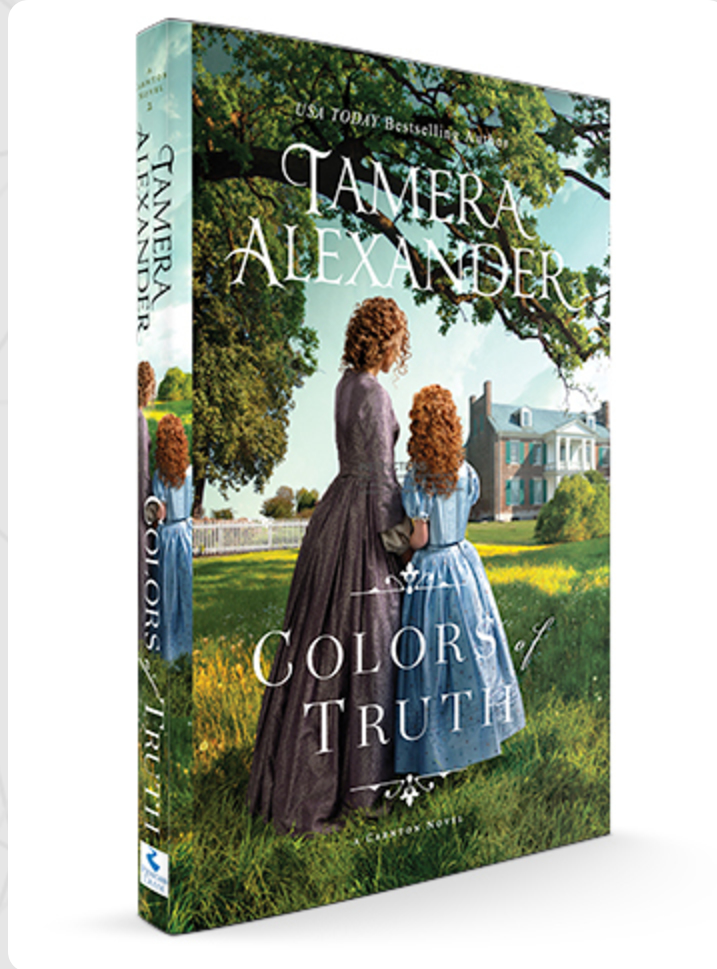
