A NOTE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear LSU Families.

Greetings. I write to say hello and to introduce myself. During the next several months, while the LSU Board of Supervisors



conducts the search for a permanent university leader, I will be serving as Interim President of LSU. It is an honor and a privilege and I will be communicating with you regularly to let you know what's happening on our campuses. To tell you a bit about myself, for the past three and one-half years, I've been the Dean of LSU's Paul M. Hebert Law Center, the place where I started my academic career in 1986 and where I taught and wrote about law until 1998. Between 1998 and my return to LSU in 2016, I served for eight years as the Dean of the University of Tennessee College of Law and for ten years as president of Colby-Sawyer College in New Hampshire.

Even though I've been a dean twice and college president once before, at heart, I am and will always be a teacher. I'm passionate about my subjects and my students matter to me. Here at LSU, the teaching and learning of our students is at the core of what we do. We would not exist without our students. Their learning and our teaching is the center and launching point for everything else—research, scholarship, creative activity, and athletics.

I'm excited to get to know your Tiger and their peers over these next few months and see what the future holds for all of our students at this great university.
