Camp in Snow - The 1944 and 1948 Andover-Harvard Yukon Project was a series of archaeological and geobotanical expeditions carried out jointly by the Peabody and Harvard University in the Shakwak and Dezadeash Valleys of the southwestern Yukon territory of Canada. This image, taken by Hugh Miller Raup on August 23, 1948, depicts a tent within the expedition camp at Burwash. 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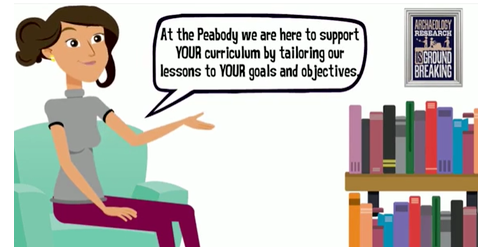

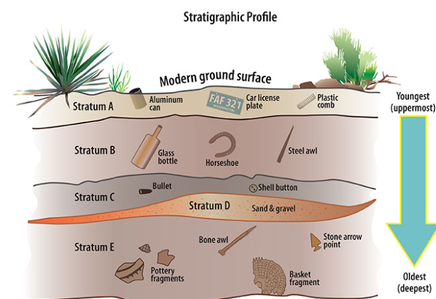


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C14 Dating the Collection
