

## Job and Internship Opportunities

**About the Scholarships**  
GRE Preparation and Research Scholarships provide up to \$2,000 to undergraduate students in pursuit of research-related and/or graduate school opportunities, which can include research internships and/or graduate research assistantships. Research-related stipends support for research. GRE preparation courses provided by the McNair Program in Spring 2019, and graduate school application expenses in Fall 2019.

**Program Eligibility**

- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Preference is made to veterans and to low-income, first generation (or underrepresented students in certain disciplines)

**Eligible Majors (in 6 Majors Only)**

- Chemical Engineering
- Chemistry
- Computer Science
- Earth Science
- Electrical Engineering
- Environmental Studies

**GRE Prep Scholarship Deadline:** no later than February 21, 2019 @ noon

Research scholarships applications are accepted throughout the academic year.

Research stipends are awarded to students who are accepted for a research position at a graduate school or who are accepted for a research position at a graduate school and are currently supporting their efforts.

**SUMMER RESEARCH PROGRAM**

**About the Program**  
Students participate in research under the direction of a faculty mentor, meet weekly as a seminar for professional development, and present a poster at the UCSB colloquium series in August 2019. Program one then runs 24 through August 16, 2019 and provides a stipend of \$1,000.

**Program Eligibility**

- GPA of 3.0 or higher
- Students must be engaged in research at UCSB during Summer 2019
