Construction at Wilder Hall, Oberlin’s historic student union building, resumed in July and will continue through summer 2026. The project, which is the second phase of a comprehensive multi-year renovation,

will focus on upgrades to the third floor. Highlights include new spaces for various Student Affairs offices and student organizations, as well as the creation of an esports arena. While access to the third floor will be limited to offices on the west end of the building through 2025-26, most of Wilder will remain in use during this period.
