LEGISLATIVE UPDATE: CALIFORNIA RELEASES NEXT PHASE OF COVID-19 RESPONSE, INDOOR MASK MANDATE SUNSETS

Governor Newsom announced a shift yesterday in the state's COVID-19 response from pandemic to endemic via the release of the "California Smarter" plan. SMARTER stands for: Shots, Masks, Awareness, Readiness, Testing, Education, and Rx (for evolving treatments, as opposed to vaccine shots). This shift comes a full two years after the Governor imposed the statewide stay-at-home order. This less restrictive approach will include encouraging masks and vaccines particularly in high-risk settings or during times of high transmission. 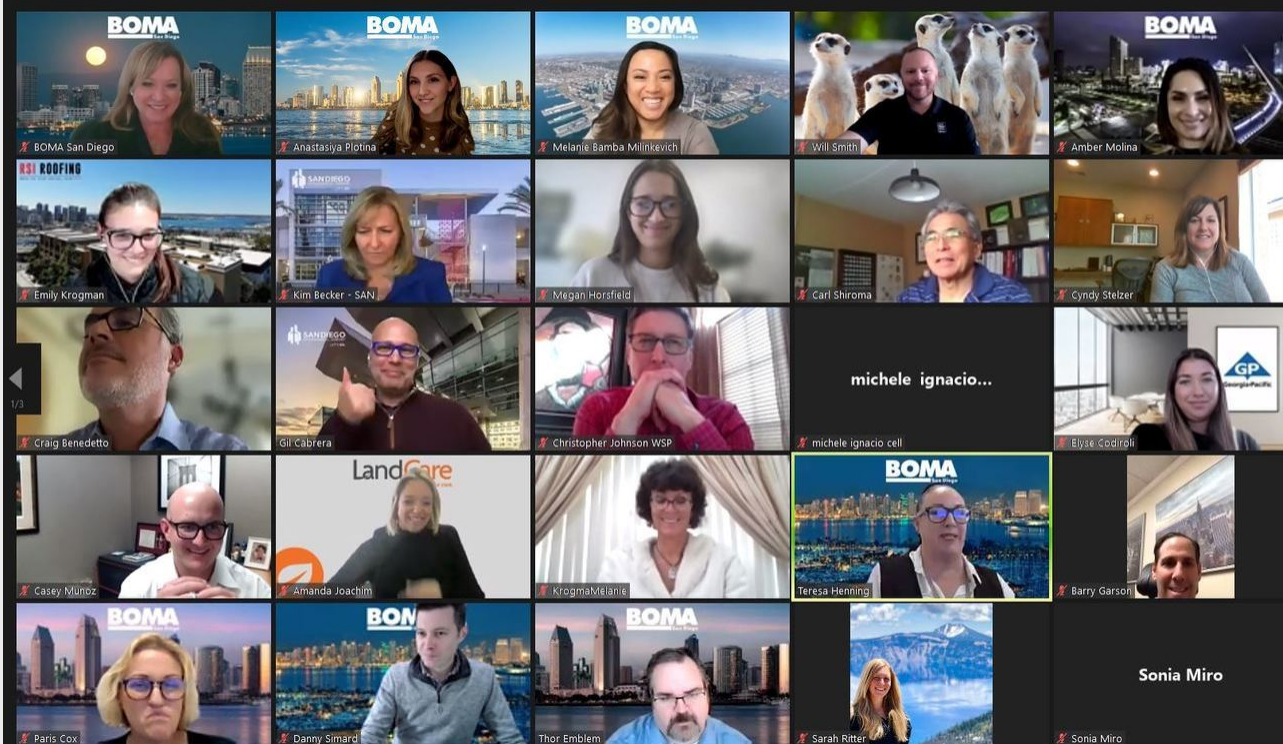

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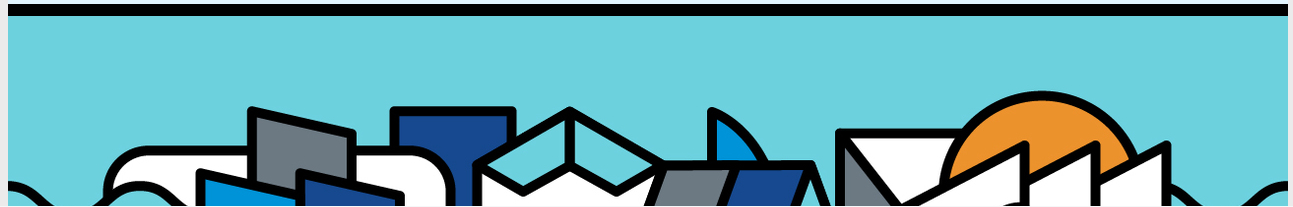
