first-year enrollment from the 2023-2024 academic year and is the second consecutive year that the College has surpassed the enrollment target.

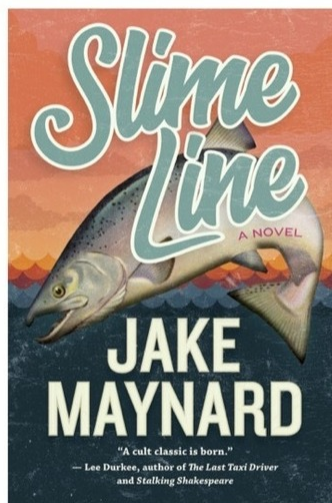

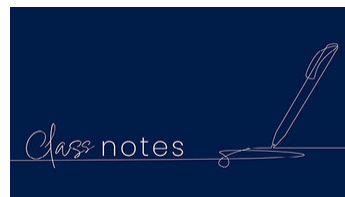
