Writing Retreat

Michigan State University's Outreach and Engagement Department is organizing a <u>writing retreat</u> on 19-20 October in Grand Rapids. The program encourages Faculty, Extension and Academic Staff, Post-Docs, and Graduate Students to bring along their public/practitioner pieces, journal articles, books, curricula, theses or dissertations, grants, conference papers, or any other significant written works that could benefit from dedicated writing attention.

Cost for the retreat are as follows:

MSU participants: \$380 Double hotel occupancy: \$300 Day rate (no overnight): \$250 Non-MSU participants are very welcome to participate at \$480

Registration fees include hotel accommodation at Embassy Suites Grand Rapids Downtown along the Grand River for the night of October 19. Breakfasts, lunches, and snacks on October 19 and 20 are also included, as are all retreat materials and consulting. Dinner on October 19 is on your own.
