National Prescription Drug Take-Back

The National Prescription Drug Take-Back will be held on April 30, 2016 from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm. This is an opportunity to return unwanted, unneeded, or expired prescription drugs for safe disposal. Collection sites can be found at http://www.dea.gov.

What's the Deal with 6-mp and Dairy Products?

The recommendation has been that kids taking 6-mercaptopurine cannot have dairy within two hours of taking their medication. Recent evaluation of the origin of that recommendation found it was based on the fact that unpasteurized milk contains an enzyme (xanthine oxidase) which can inactivate 6-mp. We now know that the pasteurization process of milk inactivates this enzyme. So there is no risk of inactivating 6-mp from pasteurized milk and dairy products. Also, taking 6-mp with food does not alter its effectiveness. So enjoy your dairy and healthy bedtime snacks!
