A NOTE FROM THE PRESIDENT

Dear LSU Families,

I know that many of you have been adversely affected by the devastation of Hurricane Ida. While some of you are working to get your homes and lives back in order, please be assured that we are here to help our students who have been impacted. If your Tiger needs mental health support, emergency



financial aid, or is struggling with food insecurity, please urge them to utilize these <u>resources</u>. We will do all we can to help them get through this difficult time.

Fortunately, we have brighter news on the COVID-19 front. More than 82% of our students and 72% of employees have been vaccinated thus far. To help prevent a COVID outbreak on campus, we continue to evaluate wastewater from campus buildings and to test all students living in areas where the virus is present. We also established a randomized testing program for unvaccinated students that provides our health officials with an understanding of how and where the virus is affecting our student population. When combined, our design strategies provide students with a safe and sustainable residential college experience. Our mitigation efforts have been recognized by the



Most insurance plans will cover the full cost; if students do not have coverage or opt out of filing to their plan, the cost is \$15. 
University College - Center for Freshman Year (UCFY): Check out our October Newsletter here!
