Our spring exhibition [Portals_Thresholds](#) is on display in the Reinberger Gallery through June 15. The exhibition features work by Sara Ludy, Rachel Rossin, and the artist collaborative Wickerham & Lomax, and focuses on themes relating to science fiction, artifice and simulated reality. The artists all approach their work through multiple disciplines, including painting, sculpture, virtual reality, and video, creating art that stands at the precipice of the recognizable and the seemingly unfamiliar. It's an imaginative and at times humorous plunge into the fantastic and the strange, where the viewer is invited to test the boundaries of perception and to question concepts of reality.

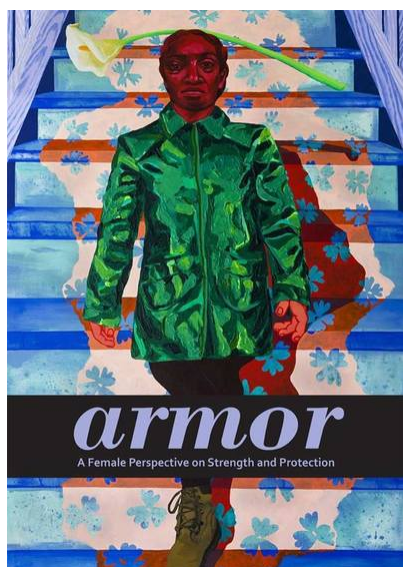
