Employers add about 250 jobs in Spokane County

Employers in Spokane County added a net of about 250 jobs in May, according to preliminary figures provided by the Washington state Employment Security Department. The unemployment rate for May came in at 5%, down from 5.5% April but up from 4.7% in May 2018.
