Oracle Planning and Budget Tool (EPBCS) – Scheduled System

Downtime for Planned Update: 11/09/21 – 11/16/21

First, we are on track to release the reconfigured Resource Commitment Tracking Tool and some budgeting enhancements by **Tuesday, November 16!** The basic concepts of resource commitment tracking remain the same, and the key benefits of this reconfiguration include, but are not limited to:

- Streamlined actions
- Automatic calculations
- Improved alignment between planned resource commitments and how they are transacted on the GL

We are currently updating existing Knowledge Base Articles, KBAs, to release alongside the reconfigured tool - Stay tuned!

In order to minimize disruption and ensure the quality of your data, **the EPBCS production (Planning) environment will go offline at 5:00pm next Tuesday, November 9**, after the October GL journal submission deadline. It will be back **online starting Tuesday, November 16**. During the scheduled downtime, users will not be able to log into EPBCS production (Planning) environment nor will they be able to run any reports or ad hoc queries using EPBCS data, including reports linked to the Budget and Financial Management Reporting Panorama.

We look forward to the release of the reconfigured tool, and hope you will find the updates lead to a significantly improved user experience.

IDC Assessment is now Per Transaction

IDC Assessment is applied on an **assessment per cost transaction** basis as of November 5. The IDC assessment calculation is run daily with charges applied to each transaction that is subject to IDC. The IDC (burden) cost will have the same Expenditure Organization and Expenditure Item date as the direct cost. Future releases of Oracle may include a direct reference to the direct cost transaction number, but that feature is currently not available. This change will create more individual costs, but will help to reconcile IDC on sponsored projects.



Financial Accounting Program, Winter Quarter Application Open!

The UC San Diego Financial Accounting Program Application for Winter Quarter is currently active and open until **Friday, November 19!** We have updated the application from Fall Quarter to include clearer instructions and modified a few questions. Please note that the first page of the application will display an overview of how many sections of questions there will be. Once you proceed to the next page of any section, you will not be able to return to the previous page.

If you are interested in starting in Spring or Summer Quarter, we encourage you to also apply. We are continuously looking to fill seats in future quarters and it will provide us a better picture of demand.

Additionally, we are looking to support as many course interests as possible so keep an eye out for a question that offers the option to select your interest in completing the entire program or select courses.

Oracle Redwood Launching January 2022

In July 2021, changes to the Oracle Sign In page were communicated as part of a larger transition to the new Oracle Redwood User Interface (UI). In January 2022, after the Winter Break, UC San Diego will introduce Oracle's Redwood theme to our campus.

What is changing?

Overall coloring using a different color palette, layout, look and feel:

- Dark, global header
- Slightly darker background
- A shift from icons to tabs on the Oracle homepage

What is not changing?

The Oracle Redwood theme is a UI change only, and does not impact performance of the system:

- No changes to the underlying database
- No changes to the data within the Oracle applications
- No changes to your ability to perform tasks or functions within OFC
- No impact to any integrations or external system

Red vs. Yellow Icon Alerts in Concur

There are two types of alerts in Concur:



Yellow icon alerts provide information for the user's consideration when submitting a Request or Expense Report; the expense can be submitted. You may proceed with completing and submitting the Expense Report.



Red icon alerts indicate a hard stop related to a COA/POETAF error or a policy requirement; the expense cannot be submitted. You must change or remove the expense in order to resolve the alert error. Note that the error alert message will remain in the audit trail as a Previous Comment.
