



Diapers, Blankets & Hope:

Christ Child Delivers Hope for Holidays with the help of new partner, Skutt High School

Youthful energy, hearts for service – and lots of diapers – combined for a bundle of impact in December for hundreds of new moms and their babies.

About four dozen students from Skutt Catholic High School assisted Christ Child Society of Omaha in assembling our latest round of layettes on December 11 – 500 diaper bags in all.

“There will be dozens and dozens of moms getting a little bit of hope before Christmas,” said Janet Nichting, Christ Child Society of Omaha’s Vice President-elect.

The layettes, as usual, were packed with plenty of essentials – from diapers, pacifiers and wash cloths to footed sleepers, hooded towels and storybooks. This round also included our sewing volunteers’ always-appreciated hand-made baby blankets and new additions of digital thermometers and nail clippers, suggestions from our agency partners.



“We hope the layettes give new moms a sense of hope; for them to know there are people who care about them and want them to have the resources they need to support their families. We’ve been told the moms who receive our bags feel just that way – it gives them a spark and a lift,” Janet said.

Typically, an assembly of 500 layettes takes about 3-4 hours. With the swarm of support from Skutt, including members of the freshmen boys' football team and officers from Skyhawks for Life (Skutt's pro-life group), this pack wrapped up in about an hour.

"It was unbelievable," Janet said. "The kids were great. They were resourceful. They were thoughtful, and they had ideas on how to make the process run even smoother."

Christine French, Skutt's campus minister, said partnering with Christ Child Society of Omaha was a gift.

"Here, we want to form and educate Christian leaders to empower others, promote justice and initiate change – that's part of our mission statement," Christine said. "We see doing service and encountering people as an opportunity for our students to grow to encounter Christ. The more they're involved in these types of efforts the better."

Thanks to our generous donors, Christ Child Society of Omaha distributes 1,500 layettes each year. This latest batch of 500 will be delivered to 22 agencies in Omaha, Council Bluffs, Fremont and Lincoln, including OneWorld Community Health Centers, Bergan Mercy, Open Door Mission and the St. Vincent de Paul Society.

Christ Child Society of Omaha would also like to thank Skutt Assistant Principal Michael Bailey, Christine French, the student volunteers, and the rest of the Skutt community for their incredible assistance with this year's project, which included COVID-era precautions.
